Mission Trip Opportunity

Participants: Must be 18 years of age or older or be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Date: April 5– April 13, 2010

Cost: \$1,850

(Subject to change based upon cost of transportation.)

Includes:

- Air fare from San Francisco (departure from SFO is approximately 9:00 p.m. with check in beginning at 5:00 p.m.)
- Ground transportation while in Philippines
- Housing while in Philippines
- Meals while on Christians' Haven Campus
- Historical tour of Manila

Does not include:

- Personal transportation to and from San Francisco
- Misc. meals while not on Christians' Haven Campus (4 to 6 meals)

Payment schedule deadlines:

- December 31, 2009 - \$50 application fee (non-refundable)
- January 15, 2010 - \$600
- February 15, 2010 - \$600
- March 15, 2010 - \$600

Purpose and Goals of Trip:

1. This will be a "participation" trip.
 - a. Each team member will participate in the life of a CH child and experience a week with former street children.

- b. Each team member will participate in outreach programs conducted by CH children including:
 - ✓ Street feedings.
 - ✓ Prison ministry.
 - ✓ Discipleship training.
2. As a team member you will expand your world view considerably and see God's world in a much different light.

Preparation for a Successful Mission Trip:

1. Physical Preparation includes:
 - a. Good health prior to leaving the country as medical care in the Philippines is not what Americans are accustomed to and most insurance carriers do not cover clients when traveling abroad.
 - b. No immunizations are required to travel to the Philippines but you may choose to consult with your physician. Most will recommend Hepatitis A and B as well as current Tetanus.
2. Legal Preparation includes:
 - a. Current Passport (must not expire within 6 months of travel date to the Philippines).
 - b. No Visa is required for travel to the Philippines.
3. Spiritual Preparation includes:
 - a. Recruiting no less than 8 prayer warriors (one for each day of your trip).
 - b. A daily pre-trip study will be sent to you as soon as your application is approved.
 - c. Recommended reading includes (will be sent to you when application is approved):
 - *Disciple* by Jaun Carlos Ortiz
 - *More Than a Carpenter* by Josh McDowell
 - d. Prepare your testimony to share with CH family.
